

UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN/FORD-EEOC ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Brief Description: In 1983, Ford Motor Company entered into a Conciliation Agreement resolving the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission's (EEOC's) 1973 charge of discrimination against Ford Motor Company and the United Automobile Workers. The provision of the Agreement endowed specified colleges and universities with funds to be used to provide scholarships in perpetuity for minority and female employees of Ford Motor Company and their eligible spouses and offspring. Under Ford Motor Company's Educational Endowment and Grants Program, scholarship funds are made available annually to meet their designated purpose.

Amount of Scholarship: The amount of awards vary, based on the income from the endowment each year. In most recent years, it has been \$2,500, but it is not always that amount.

Deadline for Application for the Scholarship: The deadline date changes each year, but typically falls on the first day of March, unless that day falls on a weekend.
